

Lytle Creek CMP Rifle Match

- Dates of competition: Jan 30, Mar 12, May 29, Jul 30, Sep 11, Nov 12 2011
- Sponsored by: Brea Rifle & Pistol Club
- Directions to Range: Exit Interstate 15 at Sierra Ave (Fontana, California.)
Drive north on Sierra Ave. (Name changes to Lytle Creek Rd.)
Proceed north approx. 11 miles to the end of pavement.
The entrance to the "Lytle Creek Firing Line" is on the right.
The Lytle Creek Firing Line gate is unlocked about 8:00 AM.
- Sign in: Sign in at the Lytle Creek Firing line registration building.
You will be asked to pay the \$14.00 entrance fee, and sign a liability waiver.
Ask for directions to "Area J", which is to the right through the parking lot, then left, up the hill to the Brea Rifle & Pistol Club range.
- Notarized Affidavit: Each person participating in a CMP event is required to have a Signed and Notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file with the Match Sponsors. Call or write us (see below) and we will send a copy of this paperwork so you can get this taken care of ahead of time.
- Competition is open to: Open to all.
- Match fee: \$15.00
- Entries close: Advanced entries are preferred. Entries received by Wednesday preceding match will be acknowledged.
(Include phone number.)
- Post entries: Post entries will be accepted on the morning of the match until all ten firing points are filled. If there are sufficient entries a second relay will be added. Call the day before the match. We have no idea how popular these matches will be.

- Firing starts: AT 9.00 AM

- Rules: Current CMP Competition rules will apply.
- Rifles: Any rifle (up to .35 caliber) may be used.
Any shooter using a Rifle not satisfying Rule 6.3
"As-Issued Military Rifle Rules" Will be scored in a separate
"Match Rifle class."
- Ammunition: Each competitor will provide their own ammunition,
Safe and appropriate for use in the Rifle they will be Shooting.
- Match Schedule The course of fire will be the "As Issued Military Rifle Match Course B".
55 Shots as follows (all stages fired on NRA SR-1 Targets at 100 yards):

5 Sighting Shots Any Position (Time as necessary to adjust sights).
20 Shots Slow fire Prone (Two 10 minute strings ?).
10 Shots Rapid fire Prone from Standing in 80 seconds.
10 Shots Rapid fire, Sitting or Kneeling from Standing, in 70 Seconds.
10 Shots Slow fire Standing Offhand in 10 Minutes.
- Scoring Scoring will be done at the target frames following each string. Even
numbered shooters will score the targets to their left and odd numbered
Shooters will score the targets to their right. The range master will be
Available, with plug gauges to help resolve scoring questions.
- Awards: We will try to find some ribbons to present to the good
shooters.
- General information: A portable toilet is located at the range (wheelchair accessible.)
Bring bottled water and a box lunch and snacks.
Shooters are urged to wear long sleeve shirts and wide brimmed hats.
The firing points are uncovered and the range is at an elevation of 4500
feet - sunburn happens.
It would be wise to bring a sweatshirt or jacket (or both) during the late fall
or Winter.
The nearest motels are located on Foothill Blvd in the city of Fontana about
30 minutes from the range. A forest service campground is located in the
village of Lytle Creek, about 4 miles from the range.
